

• When you first access to our LMS site, you can see this page.




Sign in & Create an Account

- If you are a student who does not belong to any campus, please do not select a campus.






Log in & Level Test

Level Test & Check the Level


•After completing the **Level Test**, click the **Back button** at the top.

Your **Level Test results** will be automatically saved on the site and can be checked in the **Application menu**.

•You can retake the Level Test as many times as you like from My Page. If you achieve a higher level upon retesting, the new level will be automatically updated and reflected in the Application menu.









How to assign the class?(Application Banner)

When you click "Application", the tab "New" will be highlighted, showing the results of available classes accordingly to their level Test. For example: Their level is E4 and the result will show E4-1, E4-2 classes with all their dates, times, prices accordingly.

If you want to take a class at a **higher level than your Level Test**result, or if the available classes for your current level **do not fit** your schedule and you need to adjust your level, click the "Find New Classes" button.


If you click [Find New classes] button, the pop up to select LV / Curriculum will appear > filter result of search accordingly.







How to assign the class? (Application Banner)




When you click "Application" > tab "History", the history of your class applications will be here.



OStudents can view their assigned classes here.

You can check details such as their level, book title, unit to be covered, assigned teacher, and class capacity.




1.On class days, the "Ready" button will be displayed. One hour before class starts, the "Enter" button will appear, allowing students to enter the Global Campus lobby and move to the Metaverse classroom.

(You can check the guideline "how to get enter to the metaverse from LMS site.)

- 2.After class starts, the "Feedback" button will appear along with the attendance status (Present/Absent).
- 3.Clicking the "Feedback" button allows you to complete the satisfaction survey for that day's class.







You can rate your satisfaction with the class using a star rating system.

After selecting the stars, you need to click "Submit" to complete the process.













Password Update:










When you click the notification button, all notifications received by the specific student will be displayed. These notifications are primarily sent by the administrator.

Study Room




In the **Study Room**, you can explore various programs introduced on the homepage.

Class Report




In the Class Report Banner, you can directly view reports written by your teachers.
